Meet our trustees

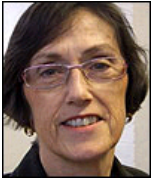
Our trustees are volunteers responsible for the accountability of Headliners, and make sure we are operating within budget and according to our objectives.

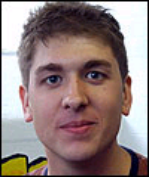
Annabel McLeod, graduate trustee
