Blast into the Past

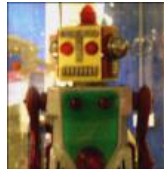

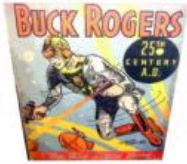

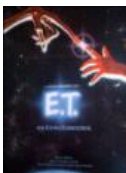
